- **Floaties** – When not in use by a human they need to be secured on your boat.
- **Parking** – City enforcement will be ticketing.
- **Swimming** – No Swimming within the marina.
- **Dogs on Leash** – It's the law.
- **Secure Lines** – Lake levels are changing, lots of wakes, check them and adjust.
- **Non Tenant Access** – Keep an eye out
- **Alcohol & Open Containers** – Keep it on your boat.
- **Trash** – Pack out what you can!

Floaties, Inflatables & the like: Please do not leave them in the water when not in use, stow them on board. The marina is tight; they can pose a hazard to your neighbors as well as catching under the docks causing damage.

Parking: We have been notified that City Parking enforcement has been ramped up! We encourage, carpooling, parking off site, walking from home. Make sure you bring your parking permit to park in the lots. Parking has been ticketed recently on medians and loading areas.

Swimming: For you and your families safety swimming (for humans or dogs) is never allowed in the marina. Electric Shock Drowning is real. <https://www.electricshockdrowning.org/>

Leash Law: For the safety of all please be mindful and keep your pets on a leash.

Secure Lines: As we know the Lake will be getting rough with all of the added traffic! Please secure your boats, make sure to use snubbers and give some slack in the lines. Also the lake has dropped about one foot recently so please adjust accordingly.

Non Tenant Access: Please don't prop open any gates! For the security of your boats, access to the docks and Island area is reserved for our tenants, family and invited guests.

Alcohol & Open Containers – Keep it on your boat. Alcohol Enforcement will be patrolling by land and water. Be mindful of the laws as they pertain to boaters and minors.

Trash – Please be mindful of our limited trash and pack out what you can!
